The undersigned official inspector hereby certifies that:

1. The products forming the present consignment originate from an approved zone and that they satisfy the requirements of Directive 2006/88/EC.
2. The products forming the consignment belonging to the species susceptible to Bacterial Kidney Disease (BKD), Infectious Hematopoietic Necrosis (IHN), Viral Hemorrhagic Septicemia (VHS) and Gyrodactylus salaris, but they originate from the aquaculture establishment which is under the supervision of the competent authority, and which at the time of the year the diseases are expected to manifest themselves, have been submitted for at least two years to inspections by competent authority, with sampling at least equivalent to those sampling programs laid down in Commission Decision 2015/1554/EC or surveillance methods as described in the OIE Manual of diagnostic tests for aquatic animals, Chapter 1.1.4 and the relevant disease chapters, and as laboratory tests have been carried out accordance with the relevant chapters in the most current edition of the OIE Manual of diagnostic tests for aquatic animals, with all tests giving negative results.
3. The products have not been in contact with other live aquatic animals, eggs or gametes of a lower health status.
4. The products are not intended for destruction or slaughter for the eradication of diseases listed in Annex IV, Part II, of Directive 2006/88/EC.
5. The products are not originate form a farm subject to any prohibition for animal health reasons.
6. No unexplained mortality has been reported during the last three months at the farm of origin, broodstock sited and hatchery.
