- 3) The exported material contains fish oil and/or bovine gelatin as the ONLY animal derived material.
 - a. Contains bovine gelatin which is:
 - i. derived from hides/skins and/or
 - ii. derived from the bones of bovines and originates in region(s) considered by APHIS to be of ¹negligible risk for BSE and is exported from Norway, a region considered by APHIS to be of ¹negligible risk for BSE and/or
 - iii. derived from the bones of bovines and originates in region(s) considered by APHIS to be of ¹controlled or ¹undetermined risk for BSE and is exported from Norway, a region considered by APHIS to be of ¹negligible risk for BSE, and:
 1. the bones were derived from bovines that passed ante and post mortem inspection,
 2. the bones did not include skull or vertebral column from bovines 30 months of age or older and
 3. the bones were subjected to a process that includes all of the following steps:
 - a. degreasing,
 - b. acid demineralization
 - c. acid or alkaline treatment
 - d. filtration, and
 - e. sterilization at 138 degrees C for a minimum of 4 seconds
- 4) the exported material was not commingled with materials ineligible for entry into the United States.
