The undersigned official inspector hereby certifies that the product(s) described above meet(s) in every respect the requirements stipulated under Regulation (EC) 1069/2009 and Regulation (EC) 142/2011, laying down health rules as regards animal-by-products and derived products not intended for human consumption and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002 (Animal by-products Regulation):

- a) Contains exclusively fish oil not intended for human consumption;
- b) Has been prepared and stored in a dedicated fish processing plant approved, validated and supervised by the competent authority, in ways that prevent cross-contamination of category 3 material with category 1 and 2 materials;
- c) Has been derived from fish and other sea animals, except sea mammals, caught in the open sea for the purposes of fish meal production and/or fresh fish materials from establishments manufacturing products for human consumption;
- d) The product does not contain and is not derived from:
 - Either:
 - Specified risk material as defined in Annex V to regulation (EC) No 999/2001 or mechanically separated meat obtained from bones of bovine, ovine or caprine animals; and the animals from which this product is derived have not been slaughtered after stunning by means of gas injected into cranial cavity or killed by the same method or slaughtered by laceration of central nervous tissues by means of an elongated rod-shaped instrument introduced into the cranial cavity.
 - Or:
 - from bovine, ovine or caprine materials other than those derived from animals born, continuously reared and slaughtered in a country or region classified as posing a negligible BSE risk by a decision in accordance with Article 5(2) of Regulation (EC) No 999/2001.
- e) Has met requirements in accordance with Regulation (EC) 142/2011 Annex X, Chapter II, Section 3.
- f) The final product was packaged in new packing material or in the case of dispatch as bulk transport: container or any other means of transport was thoroughly cleaned and disinfected with a disinfectant approved by the competent authority before use;
- g) The packaging bear labels indicating "NOT FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION".
