1. The dairy plant is approved by and subjected to supervision and inspection from the Norwegian Food Safety Authority.
2. The products are manufactured in compliance with official Norwegian Regulations and according to the:
  - a. Regulation (EC) No 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 28 January 2002 laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety.
  - b. Regulation (EC) No 852/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 29 April 2004 on the hygiene of foodstuff.
  - c. Regulation (EC) No 853/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 29 April 2004 laying down specific hygiene rules for food of animal origin.
  - d. Regulation (EC) No 854/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 29 April 2004 laying down specific rules for the organisation of official controls on products of animal origin intended for human consumption.
  - e. Commission Regulation (EC) No 2073/2005 of 15 November 2005 on microbiological criteria for foodstuffs
3. The products have been prepared, packed, stored and transported under good hygienic practice and an effective food safety control system.
4. The products may freely be sold in Norway.
5. The milk or milk-based products were produced from raw milk derived from animals originated from premises in the above-mentioned exporting country which were not under restrictions due to foot-and-mouth disease or rinderpest.
6. The milk or milk-based products originate from areas free from foot-and-mouth disease during the last 12 months and where vaccination against foot-and-mouth disease has not been carried out during the last 12 months.
7. The milk or milk-based products were processed at an officially approved manufacturing plant and subjected to the process of pasteurisation of a minimum of 72 °C for more than 15 seconds before being introduced into the South African territory.
8. The exported products do not contain other products derived from animals than milk or milk-based products.
9. The milk or milk-based products do not contain any additives and are found fit for human consumption.
10. The milk or milk-based products do not, to the best of my knowledge and belief, constitute any danger of introducing infectious or contagious diseases into South Africa.
