IV. I, being an official veterinarian of the government of Norway, declare the following:

- 1) The following diseases have never been recorded in Norway:
Porcine reproductive and respiratory syndromes (PRRS), transmissible gastroenteritis (TGE), Teschen disease and swine vesicular disease.
- 2) Norway has been free from foot and mouth disease since 1952 and classical swine fever (hog cholera) since 1963.
- 3) The semen is derived from an artificial insemination centre which is licensed by the Norwegian Animal Health Authority and is under the supervision of a veterinary surgeon.
- 4) The semen is derived from boars which have been kept at the artificial insemination station centre for more than six months prior to the collection.
- 5) Prior to entrance to the semen station the boars are tested negative for tuberculosis and porcine brucellosis. Leptospirosis has never been diagnosed in the AI station.
