IV. I, being a District Veterinary Officer of the government of Norway, declare the following:

- 1) The following diseases have never been reported in Norway: African Swine fever, Teschen Disease, Swine Vesicular Disease, Transmissible Gastroenteritis, Aujeszky's Disease (Pseudorabies), Vesicular Stomatitis, PRRS (Blue Ear Disease), Rinderpest and all subtypes of Influenza A virus except pandemic Influenza A H1N1.
- 2) Norway has been free from Foot and Mouth Disease, Brucellosis and Classical Swine Fever (Hog Cholera) for the last 10 years.
- 3) The semen is derived from an artificial insemination centre which is licensed by the Norwegian Animal Health Authority and is under the supervision of a veterinary surgeon.
- 4) The semen is derived from boars which have been kept at the artificial insemination station centre for more than six months prior to the collection.
- 5) The donor boars come from an artificial insemination centre where all animals have been tested and found free from Tuberculosis, Brucellosis, Aujeszky's disease and PRRS.
- 6) Leptospirosis has never been diagnosed in the AI centre.
